DAY 1

Disciples making disciples

DAY 2

Training Disciples

Al Massira (The Journey) trains people to present the story of the Bible in thirteen DVD sessions, journeying chronologically through the scriptures to present eternal truths in an eastern, community-oriented style.

As participants are led to an understanding of the person and work of the Messiah in the gospels, Christ becomes the answer to important questions that have been awakened in their hearts and leads them into deeper discipleship. The Al Massira resources are now available in over 30 languages.

Pray for the Al Massira groups happening all around the world - that Jesus will be known.

Pray for the new language projects underway.

Pray for those who have been trained - that they will have courage to start groups with their friends and family.

DAY 3

Sharing God's Love

All4Aid currently works on the island of Lesbos, Greece with refugee women and children by providing shower, laundry services and NFI donations as well as a place of refuge for the most vulnerable to spend some time away from camp. Our vision is to see displaced people attaining life in all its fullness (John 10:10b) and we work towards this everyday, as we continually seek to be the hands and feet of Jesus, providing basic assistance and always being ready to give an answer to those who ask about the hope we have with gentleness and respect (1 Peter 3:15).

Praise God for the opportunity to work among refugees on Lesbos, Greece and to be a part of the response to physical needs on the island.

Pray for wisdom and discernment for All4Aid as we feel God leading us to expand our work with displaced people to other transit contexts beyond Lesbos, Greece.

DAY 4

Empowering Refugees

Humanitarian Initiative Bridges is a Christian organization based in Athens, Greece ministering to displaced individuals and refugee families. Our mission is to serve refugees by addressing their unique physical, emotional, and spiritual needs so they may be integrated into society, empowered to stand on their own feet again, and trained to be disciples of Jesus Christ. We work with the vision that these precious individuals would divinely receive restoration, hope, and discipleship and plant churches in order to reach the nations.

Please pray for growth and continued investment to the many small groups and Zoom groups that have formed during the COVID time.

Pray that we can continue to encourage believers and continue discipleship among the refugee community.

DAY 5

Protecting the Vulnerable

Most of the exploited women in Athens are foreigners and refugees. We have to understand that these women are in survival mode, highly vulnerable to or have been sexually exploited or trafficked. Community House Damaris' Recovery & Residential Program has been adjusted to meet their specific needs. This demographic has a desperate need for housing, for community, for assistance with cultural integration, and we have also found many girls thirsting for the Gospel!

Please, pray that God will open doors for our beneficiaries as they are working on their asylum cases (get their papers fixed).

Pray for our beneficiaries' children, some were left back in their countries of origin while others are here in Greece, for God's provision and grace upon them.

Give thanks for the second Safe House that God granted to Damaris House.

DAY 6

Raising New Workers

We live in a city in the south of Germany where people from over 160 different nations live. God has shown us, that among these nations, He has people whom He has called to be missionaries among their people group.

Our ministry is to find these people and to train and accompany them, to reach their families and friends with the Gospel and to make them disciples of Jesus. The training goes for 6 months, where we learn together, encourage each other, and to pray for each other and for people around us.

Pray for the nations in Germany.

Pray that God will call people to be missionaries for their nation.

Pray for the 10 participants of the new training starting in October

DAY 7

Connecting Locals

Greece continues to be a key focal point in Europe for the reception and passage of refugees and asylum seekers. ECM's vision is to support Greek churches and local organizations in reaching the needs of people in the city of Athens and beyond.

The pioneering work of one Korean missionary, who simply began to share Christ's love with refugees in Athens, has developed into a strategic ministry that provides community lunches, a clothing bank, language classes and discipleship training for new believers.

Please pray for the Samaria All Nations project, and other similar small NGOs, as ECM seeks to work alongside them.

Please pray for local evangelical churches, that they would have the vision and the means to help integrate newcomers who have come to faith in Christ.

DAY 8

Advocating for Action



EEA is deeply worried about what some of Europe's response to refugees says about the societies that we have become and where we, as well as the refugees themselves, could end up. It is often said that we must uphold European values and not allow foreigners to change us. Every human life is sacred. We cannot allow this belief to be downgraded in importance. We cannot allow the suffering of people to become the accepted norm.

Pray for the asylum seekers and refugees here in Europe who are desperately worried for their families back home.

Pray that EU nations will be willing to share in the effort needed to welcome those who have the right to remain in Europe.

Pray that European politicians will remember the human beings as they worry about security, budgets and numbers.

DAY 9

Reaching those in Limbo



Thousands of Iranian and Afghan refugees are currently being housed in hostels and hotels in the UK, awaiting their final placements throughout Europe. As they wait in significant limbo, there is great opportunity to reach them with the Gospel.

Ali is an Iranian Christian working with Elam Ministries as a trained leader. He currently lives in the UK, sharing Jesus with Persian-speaking refugees and discipling new Christians. Ali has already seen 20 refugees come to Christ with 12 of these now being disciplined.

Pray for more trained leaders like Ali to faithfully share the Gospel with refugees who are only in the UK for a short amount of time.

Pray that these new Persian-speaking Christians will spread the Gospel throughout Europe.

DAY 10

Providing Safe Spaces



In Athens, Greece, there are church-based integration houses providing housing, counseling, language training, job training, and/or coaching. Also there is the Athens Ministry Centre where hundreds of refugees are helped with a variety of needs and given help to find resources that they need. Home Spot helps those in 3 camps by being a safe place, provides lessons in language and job skills, as well as providing transportation to doctors and visa appointments. These are just a few of the ways needs are being met.

Give thanks for the workers from many different countries that are serving in these ministries. Pray for more workers from various backgrounds to join.

Pray for opportunities while these needs are being met to share the Gospel and disciple those coming to faith.

DAY 11

Multicultural Germany



Approximately 5.5 million Muslims currently live in Germany. In 2015 there were 4.5 million. In 2010 there were around 3.5 million. That means that about every second Muslim who now lives in Germany has only joined in the last 10 years.

This an opportunity to show these people the love of Christ. It has never been easier for Christians in Germany to fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus on their own doorstep.

Give thanks for Christians and churches in Germany who turn to Muslims and refugees.

Pray for the refugees who started a journey with Jesus. That God may equip them with everything they need to be multipliers of the love of Christ among their compatriots.

Pray for the many families in refugee shelters who suffered so much during the Corona period.

DAY 12

Creating Pathways

Some are on the journey themselves, moving with the flow of people seeking safer places and new starts.

SIM seeks to provide pathways for these Arabic speaking believers to participate in God's harvest.

Pray for their witness to Christ in each setting.

Pray for colleagues in the Middle East and Europe as we work on new models to provide Arabic-speaking workers in too-expensive Europe with adequate financial and pastoral support; Europe is expensive!

DAY 13

Fellowship of Friends



Shalah escaped Afghanistan in the dead of winter. There was little food, and she had to carry her mother-in-law over a mountain. Finally, they made it to Greece.

That's where Shalah met Ruth, a missionary with TEAM and Helping Hands. Ruth shared the Jesus Film with her, and they began spending time together. As the weather turns cold again, Ruth and her co-workers are starting a jigsaw puzzle ministry to reach more women like Shalah. Will you pray for them?

Pray that this new puzzle outreach will draw in many women and let them clearly see God's love and comfort in the midst of their heartache.

Pray that Shalah and other Afghan refugees will come to know the love, comfort and salvation of Jesus.

DAY 14

Welcoming to New Homes



Welcome Churches exist to see every refugee and asylum seeker welcomed by their local church. We are stewards of God's command in Matthew 25:35 for us to welcome the stranger. We celebrate refugees and are very grateful for the blessing they are to the UK.

We provide training to churches to help them offer a good welcome to newly arrived neighbours. Our Welcome Network connects refugees and asylum seekers to local churches, so that they can integrate and thrive in their new communities.

Please pray for refugees and asylum seekers as they arrive and settle in the UK, that they would receive a good welcome and find a community that they can call home.

Please pray for the churches across the UK that are welcoming refugees.
